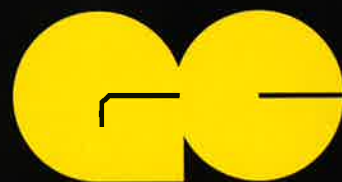

2010 / Panu Aree / Thai w/ subtitles / Thailand
New York premiere / Documentary / Desi spotlight, music, Documentary / 73 mins
The story of artists and their humble, homegrown art that puts a human face on the troubled image of Islam.



Beatles Stories

2010 / Seth Swirsky / English / USA / East Coast premiere
Documentary / Local Talent, music/ 80 mins
Seth Swirsky grew up in Great Neck, N.Y., in the 1960s, a huge fan of The Beatles. Wanting to get closer to them than their music could take him, he set out, in 2005, to film people who had a story about themselves and the Fab Four. 110 interviews later, the result is Beatles Stories.



The Best and The Brightest

Set in the world of New York City's elite private kindergartens, "The Best and the Brightest" centers on a fresh-faced young couple, Samantha and Jeff, who have only recently moved into town. The comedy centers on their dawning realization of the lengths they must go to in order to get their five-year-old daughter into school.



Bob and the Monster

A compelling portrait of outspoken indie-rock hero Bob Forrest, from his life-threatening struggle with addiction to his transformation into one of the most influential and controversial drug counselors in the US today.



Chasing Madoff

"Chasing Madoff" is the compelling story of Harry Markopolos and his team of investigators ten-year struggle to expose the harrowing truth behind the infamous Bernard Madoff scandal.



Chess Kids

World Premiere / Documentary / 80 mins
Chess prodigies compete in a World Youth Tournament. Featuring Josh Waitzkin (the real-life subject of the film, Searching for Bobby Fischer) pitted against Judit Polgar (the best female player of all time), Chess Kids gives audiences a gender bender look at the sport. A companion follow-up piece revisits these former prodigies two decades later.



Crime After Crime

"Crime After Crime" is the exclusive documentary film on the legal battle to free Debbie Peagler from prison after over two decades behind bars for her role in the murder of the man who abused her.



Fambul Tok

Victims and perpetrators of Sierra Leone's brutal war come together for the first time in tradition-based truth-telling and forgiveness ceremonies. Reviving their ancient practice of "fambul tok", Sierra Leoneans are building sustainable peace at the grass-roots level—succeeding where the international community's post-conflict efforts failed.



The Flaw

Flowers of Evil (Fleurs du mal)

A rootless love story between Gecko, young and free, and Anahita, an Iranian in exile tangled up in history and steeped in Internet. Anahita is obsessed by the current events in her country and little by little their story is contaminated by history and its breathless medication on the Internet.



Food Stamped

Holy Rollers

Gold Rush, Local Talent, drama, crime / 89 mins
"Holy Rollers" is inspired by actual events in the late nineties when Hasidic Jews were recruited as mules to smuggle Ecstasy from Europe into the United States.



Homecoming (HaShiva Ha Bayita)

Documentary / Israeli Focus / 60 mins
The quest for identity in modern Israel. Three children of foreign workers who were born in Israel travel to their parents' homelands as they seek out their roots and their own place in the world.

Little Sparrows

When their mother Susan's breast cancer returns, the family is faced with the reality of their last Christmas together.



Lucky

Narrative / comedy, drama, romantic comedy, dark romantic comedy / 103 mins
It seems like a dream come true when serial-killer Ben Keller wins the Iowa state lottery but for everyone else in his life, it's the beginning of darkly comic nightmare.



Memories in March

Siddharth, a 28-year old man, is killed in an accident and his grief stricken mother comes to Kolkata to collect his belongings. Looking through what the young Siddharth has left behind in his home, office and among his friends at the advertising agency he had recently joined, she discovers a son and a life she had not known existed. She finds she must share his belongings and her grief with others he had left behind.



My Afternoons with Margueritte (La tête en friche)

Naomi has a lover he is unable to control himself. He confronts the lover and commits a horrible act, and the consequences weigh heavily on his conscience.



Old Cats (Gatos Viejos)

Isadora, 70s, discovers that her mind is quickly fading. At an apparently relaxed dinner table, she will desperately try to hide her state from her daughter, a demanding woman who awaits any sign of senility in order to take way everything she has.



Outside Industry

Chronicling the 25 year span of South by Southwest, the film tells the story of how four guys living on next to nothing created a music event in the hopes of giving bands a way to connect with music insiders. The result was the biggest music industry event in the world.

With the Internet surpassing print as our main news source and newspapers all over the country going bankrupt. "Page One: A Year Inside the New York Times" chronicles the transformation of the media industry at its time of greatest turmoil.



Phas Gaye Re Obama

The Piano in a Factory

Rafting to Bombay (Rhapsoda le-Bombay)

Rejoice and Shout

Implicated in a traffic of new born babies, Ibrahim, with the help of his two friends, is forced to go deep into the slums of the city.
